The EAEPE Summer School is open to **PhD** students and early-career researchers working in particular in the field of institutional and evolutionary analysis, with a special focus this year on <u>labour economics</u> and <u>welfare</u>, and the impact of <u>Covid-19</u>. Lecturers will address these topics from <u>different perspectives</u> and <u>approaches</u>. In the spirit of <u>pluralism</u> characteristic of the EAEPE, many <u>Research Areas</u> are relevant: Social Economics, Public Economics, Macroeconomics, Labour Economics, Effective Demand, Economic History, Evolutionary Economics, Comparative Economics, Industrial Policy, Innovation and Technology, etc. More generally, contributions from all fields using institutional, multidisciplinary approaches are welcome. Lectures by <u>internationally renowned scholars</u> will be given in the morning, while afternoons will be devoted to presentations by <u>advanced PhD</u> students and <u>early-career researchers</u>, who will thus benefit from comments and suggestions from experts in the field.

No Summer School Fee. Participants are requested to be EAEPE members. For PhD students and those with a gross personal income less than 10,000€ per year a Special Rate Membership is available, at the price of 25€. More information here.
